

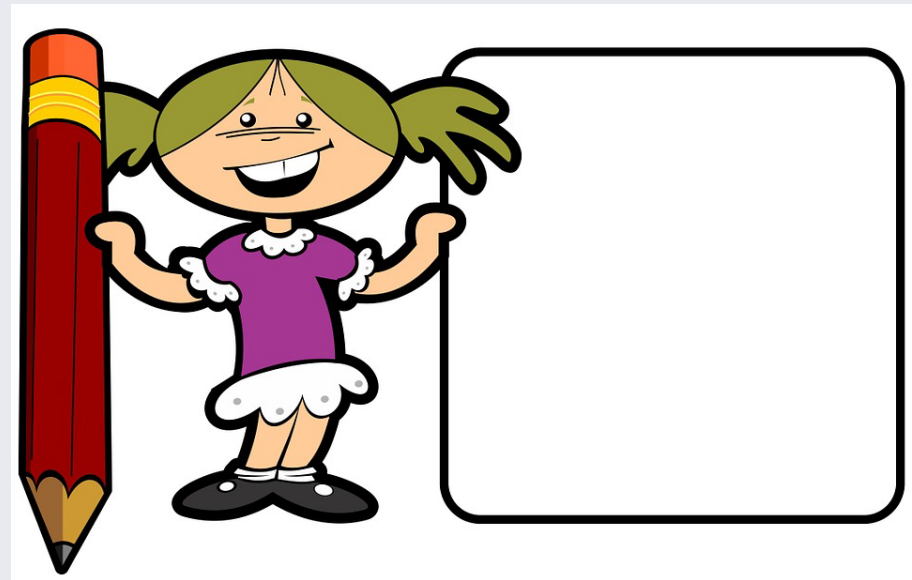
Knowing your Pacific students

Building strong relationships

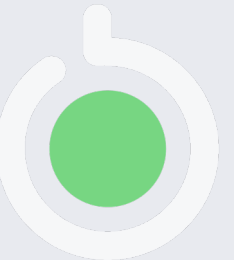
