What is tuakana-teina?




Traditional view of tuakana - teina

- Whakapapa / genealogy (Hook et al, 2007)
- social position and mana / prestige of a person was determined by the degree of whakapapa and tuakana- teina position (Buck, 1949, Mead, 2003)
- Expectations + responsibilities –
- Manifested on marae / in tribal and Post-Treaty relationships






