

The Purpose of the ELN Self-Assessment Tool

Direction

The ELN Self-Assessment Tool gives direction to its users as to what good practice in embedded literacy and numeracy looks like.



Evidence

The activity results in a judgement of an organisation's or programme's ELN outcomes and practices, including evidence for this judgement, and actions for improvement.




Aligned

The Tool is aligned with the NZQA Key Evaluation Questions.

Collaborative

It is meant to stimulate collaboration, conversation and discussion about ELN within an organisation.






Part or Whole-of-Organisation

It can be applied within an organisation as a whole or within programmes, departments or organisational units.

Time-efficient

The activity results in a comprehensive analysis of strengths and areas for improvement, but will not take up too much time.






Flexibility
