## On Understanding Māori

- Determination to survive as a people
- Complete isolation 600-800 years
- Cook 1770s
- Decades of decline 1840 1890s
  - From 90,000 to 42,000
- Physical recovery 1900 to 2000
  - From 42,000 to 600,000

### Kaupapa tuku iho

- Inherited values
  - Something we would rather have than not have
- Tikanga: right and proper ways to express kaupapa
  - Something we would rather do than not do

### **Expressor and Observer**

 Expressor of kaupapa attracts mana Person or ropū

 Observer of kaupapa attributes mana Person or ropū

## **Tikanga**

- Kaupapa tikanga framework
  - 10 kaupapa, 70 tikanga
- Many tikanga for each kaupapa
- Automatic source of innovative activity
- Imagination required



### **Streams of Knowledge**

- Tupuna Pākehā
  - Galileo 500 years ago
  - logic of exclusion

- Tupuna Māori
  - Period of isolation and earlier
  - Mātauranga continuum



### Living the Kaupapa

- Embody kaupapa in all activities
  - In whakaako, in whakatupu mātauranga, in whakahaere
- Setting targets and comparing performance
- Managing the complexities of the logic of inclusion
- The feeling, the sensation, the joy, being uplifted
- Expressing kaupapa subject to constraints
