# WORKSHOP GUIDE HŪTIA TE PUNGA

### **DISCUSSION GUIDE FOR TUTORS**

Aotearoa NZ has a great opportunity. We have a young, growing Māori population that has the potential to provide a rich pool of talent and to be the backbone of our nation's future.

However, for too long, the tertiary sector has underperformed in delivering quality education to Māori students. Hūtia Te Punga provides research insights from three very different tertiary programmes. It highlights both challenges faced and examples of best practice. This discussion guide helps you think more deeply about these and relate them to your own work and experiences. What can you learn that will enable you to more effectively ensure the success of Māori tauira as Māori?

The questions are only suggestions. You may decide to ignore some or add others more relevant to your context.

• What professional learning and development have you participated in? What were key learnings? How did it impact your teaching? How has it impacted Māori learner outcomes?

- What is your course data currently showing you e.g. Māori learner enrolments, completions? How well do you provide feedback and feed forward?
- What culturally responsive practices do you effectively utilize and what others would you like to develop?
- How do you welcome Māori students into your course?
- How do you build strong relationships with Māori learners? How effectively do you do this?
- How well do Māori tauira engage with support services? How could the effectiveness of this engagement be increased?
- What do you currently do to support students in your courses to transition to work? How effective is this? What data do you have?
- Do you already use micro credentialing or are thinking about it?
- How do you build Māori contexts into your curriculum?
- What connections do you have to Māori whānau, community, hapū and iwi? How did you build these connections and how do you leverage off them?
