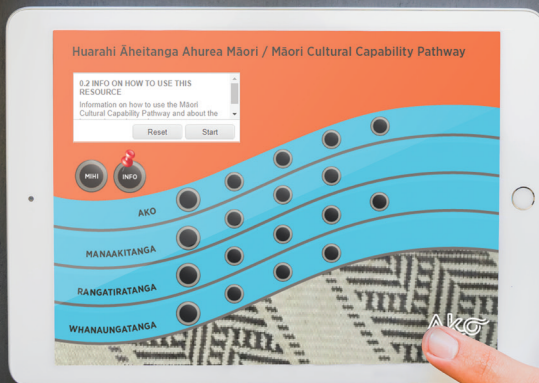


Māori Cultural Capability Pathway

The Māori Cultural Capabilities Pathway (MCCP) is an online resource targeted at tertiary practitioners and educators. The MCCP focuses on the Māori values of Ako, Manaakitanga, Rangatiratanga and Whanaungatanga. These values are presented as 14 small manageable modules.

Each interactive module in this enhanced resource includes:

- » Insights into Māori philosophies, values and practices to inform and improve practice in the classroom
- » Engaging and interactive activities (written, audio and visual) to stimulate reflection and application in your practice.

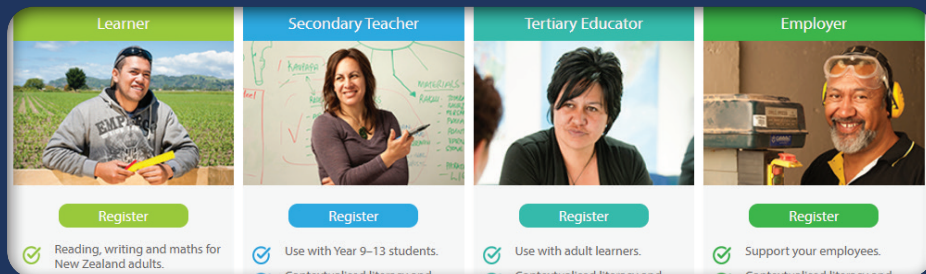
The resource can also be used as follows:

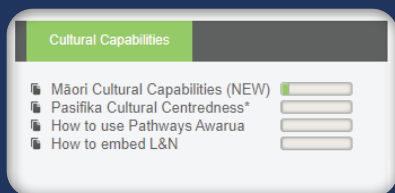


Not yet registered?
